RS reported on meeting with Steve Bogess and David Gardner at the Bus Stop Park. SB wanted (1.) to replace the bike rack, (2.) to have the 3 cedars behind the men's room removed, (3.) the benches by the Pumping Station to be painted blue and (4.) spotlight for the Park. After discussion, the Bicycle Committee has already ordered a bike rack. It has been decided to trim the tops of the cedars. BD moved, RS seconded a motion to retain grey benches. So voted 5-0. Bike rack is to be placed so as to not block the walkway to the bathrooms. So voted 5-0.

RS to commemorate Neil Toile's generous bequest to the Beautification Gift Fund will write the words for a bench plaque and report at our next meeting.

GP wants color in the traffic islands. BR suggests Galladria. VB to be consulted for re-planting of Lopes Sq. evergreens and further plans for the traffic islands, especially the Tree for Frances at Bradford and Standish Sts.

Future plans will be made by locals such as Jennifer Crooks, Vincent B. and others.
