

Minutes of Beautification Committee

Meeting of May 13, 2013 Town Hall 4:30 PM

Present: Barbara Rushmore, Ross Sormani, Vincent Breglia, Bill Docker, Ghee Patrick and Anika Costa.
Not Present: Dot Frietas, excused absence.

RS moved to approve the Minutes of 4/22/13. VB seconded. So voted 3-0, 2 abstained.

BR gave a report on the Bus Stop Park, which is now half planted. Thanks to Tony Lemme, Anthony Kalantzis, Brian Cowing, Steve Sollog and Anika Costa of the Building and Grounds.

Ground Cover for the Waterfront Park was discussed. Myrtle and Sedum were chosen, up to \$300. to be spent on a purchase from Sylvan or any other supplier with a comparable cost. The Tom Kane Farm in Truro will be visited next Tuesday by BD, VB and BR.

Financial Report by RS.

Gift Fund: \$5,550.30

Budget: \$10,534.12

1. RS moved to pay Sylvan Nurseries a bill of \$3932.75 from the Budget. BR seconded. So voted 5-0.
2. RS moved to pay Ace Hardware \$337.14 from the Budget. BR seconded. So voted 5-0.
3. RS moved to pay BR \$299.88 from the Budget. BD seconded. So voted 5-0. This was a transshipment of roses from Roseland to Pine Tree Gardens.
4. BD moved to pay \$299.60 from the Budget to Bayberry for plants for the Old Library. BR seconded. So voted 5-0.
5. RS moved to pay \$55.15 from the Budget for mulch ordered by VB from Conwell Ace. GP seconded. So voted 5-0.
6. RS moved and BR seconded to pay Bill Whitney \$450.00 from the Budget as his contract allows \$75/hr for planning. So voted 5-0.
BD made a motion and BR seconded for the Beautification Committee to thank Bill Whitney for his services.
7. RS moved \$1415.00 be spent for flowers for Lopes Sq., Town Hall and Comfort Station half-barrels. BR seconded. So voted 5-0. There are 6 half-barrels at Town Hall, 3 at the Comfort Station and 3 at the Waterfront Park.

Old Library and Islands.

VB needs bricks. He has planted and trimmed and improved the Old Library site.

We must plan for Town Hall trees in the future.

Three memorial benches will be ordered as soon as the money, \$850.00 per 6-ft bench, is received.

Tom Biggert's request to have one of the new trees at the Bus Stop Park be in memory of his mother was approved.

We will meet next on Monday, June 10th at 4:30.
