A) Motta field –

Brandon- suggests that planning needs to begin for improvements to Motta field. Believes that there are multiple projects that need repairs, and could be funded by a community preservation grant.

Brandon also suggests looking into the installation of outdoor fitness machines at Motta field behind the back stop. There is a major trend in recreation for outdoor fitness; instructors are now trying to find ways to teach outside. He will research the feasibility and pricing of those machines.

Directors Report:

- A) Halloween events – The department has planned two events for Halloween, a haunted house and our annual Halloween parade. The haunted house will be on October 29th at the community center on Bradford Street. The parade will be on October 31st at 3:30, and will start at seashore point and end at the Bradford street community center.

Repairs such as sanding and painting ramps, will help make the park look more presentable. A date has not been set, but we are looking into a month in the spring.
- C) Soccer- The department has three teams playing in Provincetown, and one 3rd and fourth grade girl's team combined and playing in Truro. The Last week of soccer will be November 9th.

- A) Open house – The building will be having an open house on November 2nd, all three departments will have their doors open and showing people around.
