The Community Preservation Commission next meets tomorrow, 2/20/14, at the VMCC @ 4 p.m. CPC funds currently are allotted 10% toward preservation, 10% affordable housing, and 10% open determination. We can anticipate an article of this year's warrant toward reallocate more toward affordable housing.

Further discussion of the town housing dilemma included the second / follow-up Housing Summit is to be held Friday, Feb. 28, 2014. An out-of-the-box suggestion was to turn to Truro, to look at year-round housing in North Truro/Beach Point.
