

Beautification Minutes of July 23, 2013, 4:30 pm at Town Hall.

Present: Barbara Rushmore, Bill Docker, Dot Frietas, Vince Breglia, Ross Sormani and Ghee Patrick.

Since the meeting of June 26th was not properly posted, the Committee re-voted all actions and at the next meeting we will approve these Minutes and those of June 26th.

RS reports the Gift Fund at \$8,103.98 and the Budget at \$2,955.25 with no outstanding bills. Obviously our Budget of \$10,000 for this year has not been transferred. BR to speak to the VSB. RS moved to spend up to \$600.00 for a brass plaque commemorating Neil Toille from the Gift Fund. DF seconded. So voted 6-0.

BD has 50 extra pavers and will have Steve of B&G set the pavers under the 2 benches at the Fishermen's Memorial Park, and the rest to be returned to Conwell Lumber.

BR will speak about the Fishermen's Memorial Park sign with Tony Lemme.

On the Bus Stop Park, BR moved to purchase from the Budget up to \$600.00 for 20 cu. yds. from Noons. So voted 5-0. It was decided to use shells from Noons for the patio area.

For a tree in sand near Cabral's Wharf, south of the blue walk, Autumn Olive, Black Locust and Shademaster Honey Locust were suggested. This is a possible donated bench location.

BD wants the Ryder and Bradford Street barrels of flowers watered by B&G as well as the Old Library.

Cigarette butt containers to be placed at every bench were purchased by the DPW. The Highway Supt. wants the posts before the Bus Station to remain orange.

The next meeting is planned for Tuesday, August 20, at 4:30 pm, Town Hall.
