Parking Space Designations

The Provincetown Board of Selectmen will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, May 26, 2015, at 6:00 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Room, Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA 02657 to receive comments from the public on the following requests:

1. Designation of a metered parking space on the northbound side of Standish Street between Commercial Street and Bradford Street, adjacent to the Governor Bradford, or to take any other action relative thereto. The space is currently a taxi stand and is just north of the unloading zone.
2. Designation of two electric vehicle charging locations each of two parking spaces at two of the following sites:

Recommendation 1: Two parking spaces just outside the entrance booth of the MacMillan Pier Municipal Parking Lot. Spaces currently occupied by Parking Department employees.

Recommendation 2: Two parking spaces along the guardrail on Ryder Street Extension near the exit of the MPL Parking Lot. Area currently not parking.

Alternative 3: Two existing parking spaces in the Johnson Street Parking Lot (existing space # 33 and #34).

Alternative 4: Two existing parking spaces on Alden Street (existing space #91 and #92).

Alternative 5: Two existing metered parking spaces on Bradford Street just west of Standish Street.

The spaces will be restricted to electric vehicles charging at the electric meter and shall be designated as tow zones, or to take any other action relative thereto.

3. Amend Parking Regulations to add Chapter 4 Section 10, Electric Vehicle Charging Zones, as follows:

ARTICLE 10 ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING ZONES

4-10-1 ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING SPACES

Electric Vehicle Charging spaces shall be designated by the Board of Selectmen. Parking at these spaces shall be limited to electric vehicles which are plugged in at the metered station.

4-10-2 DESIGNATION

- A. Two (2) parking spaces for charging of electric vehicles shall be reserved at....
B.. Two (2) parking spaces for charging of electric vehicles shall be reserved at

4-10-3 SERVICE FEE

Electric Vehicle Charging Space fees shall be based on the time spent in the space and shall be charged at a rate of \$0.25 for every 10 minutes. The fee shall apply 24 hours a day, year round.

4-10-4 PROHIBITIONS

A sign which reads, "Electric Vehicle Charging ONLY, all other vehicles may be towed" shall be placed in front of each designated space. Electric Vehicles must be connected to the meter at all times while in the space. Violators may be fined pursuant to Appendix D or towed.
