Public Comments:

- A) None

New Business:

- A) American Lung Association facility use request- American Lung Association wants to use the building for the of race on September 7, 2015. Same rate as last year with a custodian. David made a motion to approve the request. Lori seconds that motion. Motion approved.
- B) VMCC Gym roof-VMCC gym roof has a leak which has caused damage to the gym floor. Funds were approved at Town Meeting to repair roof. Once roof is fixed, floors will be fixed.

Director's Report:

- A) 4th of July- Recreation Dept is working with the Tourism Dept, Chamber of Commerce and PBG to increase float submissions this year. - B) Mildred Greensfelder basketball courts update-Basketball courts are officially done. Colors are blue and gray. Next the playground will be resurfaced and there will be a re-opening ceremony after that is complete.
- C) Benches at VMCC playground-3 new benches were purchased for the VMCC playground. The benches were paid for by the Elmer Silva fund.

Assistant Director's Report:

- A) Garden Project update- There are 14 empty flower beds in the VMCC playground. The Rec kids cleared out the weeds. DPW put in new soil. And COA and Rec planted some flowers and plants in the beds.

- B) Tball update- First game was supposed to be today but was rained out. 18 kids on the team. Next game is on Tuesday, June 9th at Motta Field.
