Conwell Street Bicycle Improvements Project

The Provincetown Board of Selectmen will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, November 9, 2015, at 6:00 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Room, Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA 02657 to receive comments from the public on the Conwell Street Bicycle Improvements Project.

Three proposed 30% draft-design roadway configurations will be presented before the Board of Selectmen for the "Conwell Street Bicycle Improvements Project". These designs accommodate pedestrian and bicycle travel along Conwell Street from Route 6 to Cemetery Road. The scope of work includes limited widening of the roadway, drainage improvements, repaving, striping reconfigurations and the potential addition of a sidewalk.

Plans and other information will be available for review no later than October 27, 2015. Plans may be viewed and obtained from the Department of Public Works, 2 Mayflower Street, Provincetown, MA 02657. Information will also be available on the Town of Provincetown website Document Center under the Highway Department portion of the Public Works Department.
