Draft - Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

The Provincetown Board of Selectmen will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, December 15, 2015, at 6 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Room, Provincetown Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown MA 02657, for the purpose of informing and soliciting input from the public regarding the draft update to the Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Plan identifies natural hazards that can affect Provincetown, assesses risk and vulnerability of the critical infrastructure in town to natural hazards, identifies actions that the town may already be undertaking to mitigate these hazards, and importantly, develops a mitigation strategy to reduce the risk faced.

The Town of Provincetown has prepared updates to the Hazard Mitigation Plan to remain in good standing with the Federal Emergency Management Agency, to keep the town eligible for federal grants which may help the community accomplish the mitigation actions set forth in the Plan. The Plan was last updated and approved in 2011.

The draft Plan will be available to the public on November 30, 2015, and may be viewed on the Town's web page, or in hard copy at the Department of Public Works located at 2 Mayflower Street, Provincetown, MA or at the Town Clerk's office located at Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA 02657.
