

Second Edition Beautification Minutes of June 26, 2013, 4:30 pm at Town Hall.

Present: Barbara Rushmore, Bill Docker, Dot Frietas, Ghee Patrick and Anika Costa from Building and Grounds. Ross Sormani, excused absence.

Due to the vigilance of Vincent Breglia, it was noticed that the original meeting of June 26th was not properly posted and all actions had to be taken up and re-voted.

BR moved to approve the Minutes of 6.10.13. DF seconds, so voted 5-0.

BR moved to pay BD for fertilizer, peat moss and manure for half-barrels from the budget, \$61.69. DF seconded. So voted 6-0.

It was decided after much discussion to purchase 8 x 16" cement pavers to go under benches in the parks: Seven in the Bus Stop Park and two in the Waterfront Park. If the cost is \$5.00 per sq. ft. each bench will require 12 sq. ft. and the total should equal \$540.00 BR moved, BD seconded for up to \$600 be spent for patio pavers for the nine benches. BD has gathered suppliers and compared cost and will supervise the placement of pavers. So voted 5-0, one abstention.

A discussion was held about the area in the center of the East end of the Bus Stop Park. A firm area is most desirable. The area could be edged out with shells, curbing or pavers, etc. We will try to make our plans at the next meeting.

BR moved \$400.00 be spent for flowers in the 3 half-barrels located behind the toilet building. BD seconded. So voted 6-0.

Lighting in the Park was tabled for the time being, as was the fence. The posts were voted 6-0 to be white. All agreed that the Bus Stop Park should be mulched.

The next meeting is planned for Tuesday, July 23, at 4:30 pm, Town Hall.
