Minutes of Thursday, October 13, 2016**

**Call to order:** 5:30 pm

**New business:**

- A) Victor Feltsam-Kayak Committee Discussion- Victor introduces himself and states that he has discussed his ideas with the Harbormaster, and believes that the Rec Dept should be in charge of creating a kayak committee, similar to the bike committee. David asks what would be expected of the Rec Dept and Rec Commission. Victor explains that the Rec Dept would be in charge of fun events and fundraisers involving kayaks in town. As well as, offering a safety course and regulating the use of the kayak racks. Victor explains that he designed and helped create the racks and that kayak owners are charged for using the racks. He would like to see the Rec Dept keep track of who uses the racks and possibly issues stickers or permits as well. David states that the Rec Commission is going to need to discuss this topic in further detail before making any decisions. David wants to be clear on what would be required of the Rec Department and its employees.

**Old Business:**

- A) Dance/Fitness Floor Update- Brandon states that there has been about \$4400 raised so far towards the new dance floor and that once more funds have been raised, we will discuss which floors to put in.
- B) CPA Discussion-Brandon states that the Rec Dept will be applying for a CPA grant to use to improve the West End Playground and Courts. This would be a multi-phase project that would start with the courts. Brandon wants to know if the commission has any other ideas or suggestions. David suggests making small improvements to the field as well.

**Director's Report:**

- A) 1<sup>st</sup> Light event- The Rec Department is looking to hold its annual police vs fire basketball game during the First Light weekend. The location is not yet determined and details still need to be finalized before confirming.
- B) Greet n' Treat- The Rec Department will be having its 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Halloween Greet n' Treat on October 28<sup>th</sup>. Kids will parade through

town in their costumes and end at Motta Field. At Motta Field, there will be a variety of local businesses and organizations that have decorated their vehicles and are handing out candy to the kids. This event has been more and more successful each year. There are about 20 vehicles signed up so far.

**Assistant Director's Report:**

- A) Clothing Swap- We are looking to have another Clothing Swap event this fall. However, we want to change the way it runs. In years past, we have been left with 15-20 bags of clothing to be donated. Last year, the local thrift stores and swap shops were unable to accept the amount of clothes we had left over. Our goal is to have people come and shop, not just drop off bags of clothes. We will be reconsidering how it is run and how we can do it differently.

David makes a motion to adjourn.
