Public Comment:

New Business:

- A) 4th of July Parade Entrants Review-Brandon reads the applications that have been submitted.

Brandon notes that he is in need of a judge for the parade entrants and asks if any commission members are available. Lori says she is available and would be one of the judges that day.
- B) 4th of July Grand Marshall-Helen Colbert wants to nominate Nancy "Swanny" Swanson as the 4th of July Grand Marshall. Helen explains that she represents a true patriot and was in the military. Helen explains that Nancy was dishonorably discharged from the military because she is gay. That ruling was recently reversed and has been changed to honorably discharged. David thanks Helen for her recommendation. Brandon reads a recommendation letter from Chris Hottle that suggests Mike Trovato and the fire department be the Grand Marshall. Bobby asks if it's possible to do something combined. Brandon said that wouldn't be a problem and he would take of the next steps in the process.

Old Business:

- A) Lions Club Motta Field Request-Brandon explains that currently, the Lions Club uses Motta Field for two days in the summer for parking: 4th of July and Carnival. This request is for an additional day on Labor Day. Formerly, they used the VMCC parking lot for fundraising but it is now a paying lot with a pay station. David makes a motion to approve the use of the field for the additional day this year but if there is significant damage then the topic will need to be revisited for next year. - A) VMCC Gym Floor-Scott Deering will be here this week to finish the gym floor. He will begin by buffing down the newly repaired area. Then next week he will be doing the urethane and then buffing and doing the urethane again. This will be at least a two week process. We will be removing all the equipment in the gym and putting it in storage container.
- B) Department Goals-Brandon reads the proposed goals. David makes a motion to approve the Department goals. Lori seconds. Motion approved.
- C) Front sign-There is a new sign being designed. It's a durable long-lasting material and will have all the departments listed underneath.

Assistant Director's Report:
