New Business:

- A) 4th of July Parade Regulation-Brandon M & David O attended the previous Board of Select meeting. At the meeting the Board voted to take out line 4 of the parade regulations which states, "Entries are not to espouse political, social or other related themes or causes." The Board also put a registration deadline in place so that all entries get reviewed prior to the parade day. The Recreation Commission will review applicants and if there is a discrepancy, the Board of Select will review the application and make the final determination.
- A) 4th of July Parade Marshall-There has been one nomination for the 4th of July Parade Marshall: Maureen Hurst. Brandon M reads nomination letter to the Commission. David O makes a motion to select Maureen Hurst as the 4th of July Parade Marshall. Lori D seconds. Motion approved 4-0.

Old Business:

- A) Skate Park Survey-Signs were posted last week at the Skate Park to remind people to fill out the online survey. So far, there have been no additional survey responses.
- B) Motta Field Land Survey-William Rogers is working on the land survey of Motta Field. William explains that the survey is almost complete. However, there are a few snags before the process can go further. William was unable to locate the deeds to two sections within the fencing of Motta Field and will need to a title exam to find it. David O. makes a motion for William to move forward with a title exam. Lori D. seconds. Motion approved 4-0.

It is up and working and we are working to try and organize the data in a clearer way. We don't have much data yet but we will have a better idea of usage throughout the summer.
