Minutes of Tuesday, June 19, 2018**

Call to order: 5:30 pm

Public Hearing:

- A) Discuss and gather community input about Motta Field upgrades & Skate Park relocation spots-

New Business:

- A) Dance floor discussion- Constance C. starts discussion and states that when the Rec Dept moved from the Community Center to VMCC the wrong floor was installed. Constance C. also explains that yoga and the COA classes don't mind the floor but most of the dance class participants have left because of the floor. Brandon M. agrees that it is time to do something about changing the floor. Brandon M. presents 3 options (see attached) for flooring possibilities. Brandon M. reminds everyone that the yoga instructor has asked specifically not to use marley flooring. Kristin H. refers to one of the options and asks if the ramp is removable and if it will be in the way on foot traffic in the hallway. Brandon M. states that the company will be coming to look at the space and see what size ramp is needed and if it would be a tripping hazard. Kristin H. asks Constance C. what her preference is for the options. Constance C. would choose option #3. Brandon M. says he will further investigate the ramp situation. David O. makes a motion to pursue and look further into option #3 for the dance room flooring. Tim D. seconds. Motion approved 5-0.
- B) 4th of July Parade entry review-Commission reads over and reviews all entries for the 4th of July parade. Kristin H. makes a motion to approve all submitted entry applications for the 4th of July parade. Lori D. seconds. Motion approved 5-0.
- C) 4th of July Parade judges-Brandon M. every year we look for judges determine trophy winners for the 4th of July parade floats and typically have a couple Provincetown community members and someone from the Rec Commission. Kristin H. mentions that she would to volunteer to be a judge. Brandon M. says that he also will ask Cass Benson.

Old Business:

- A) Motta Field survey- Brandon M. explains that he has been in touch with Town Planner and he might have some input on how to pursue the renovations for Motta Field. Brandon M. adds that Jeffrey Ribeiro has experience specifically with city parks.

Director's Report:

- A) Sports Awards banquet-We had a nice little gathering to award the kids that had participated in Rec Youth Sports this school year. Liz Lovati provided refreshments and we gave out awards. We also had a slideshow for the kids and their families to watch. We did this as part of our new Sport Incentive Program and hope it will help to increase Rec sport participation.
- B) Skate Park usage update-The people counters are in place and counting participants. I will also discuss relocation options with the Town Planner.

Assistant Director's Report:

- A) Summer Program-The Rec Summer Program begins next week. We are still taking registrations but it's filling up quickly. During the first week we are hoping to walk over the Pilgrim Monument for our first field trip.
