Old Business:

Brandon- I am still awaiting to hear a response from Mr. Carlson about the Suzanne's garden PARC grant. He told me they will be making a decision mid October.

New Business :

A) After school

Brandon – The recreation department, and the school have combined forces to make one quality after school program. We will now hold our after school program at the school. I have put a lot of thought into this, and it makes more sense for the children to be at the school. We reduce the liability risk of them taking the bus, combine resources and save money, and also there is much more for them to do at the school.

B) Recreational Facilities use form revision

Brandon- I have come up with some proposed changes we need to make to our facilities use form, they are as followed; 1) Add a place under Personal information for email.

2) Under #1 of Use of Recreational facilities Guidelines, we need to add "The request will then be approved or disapproved at the next scheduled recreation commission meeting. Approval will need a majority vote by the recreation commission."

3) Under #4 of the guidelines change from non for profit to Non-Profit.

4) Revise #8, and take out #9, #8 will read as followed: "Smoking, and the possession or consumption of Alcohol, or Drugs is NOT permitted anywhere on recreational facilities property, this includes open fields, and parking lots."

Treg- All seem legitimate, and also help define the rules of the use of a recreational facility, we need to vote to accept these rules as changed.

*Voted unanimously to accept the changed Guidelines
