**Case #2002-001 (Public Hearing Continued from January 16 and February 6, 2002)** Application by Milo Caruso of Atlantic Environmental Technologies, Inc. on behalf of Sprint Spectrum LP, under Article X, Sections 10010-10150 of the Zoning By-law, Wireless Telecommunication Towers and Facilities. The applicant seeks a Special Permit from the Planning Board to install repeater antennas and ground equipment at the property located at Mt. Gilboa Road, Map/Parcel 18-4-002. (*Residential Class B Zone.*)

**Case #2002-001 (Public Hearing Continued from January 16 and February 6, 2002)** Application by Milo Caruso of Atlantic Environmental Technologies, Inc. on behalf of Sprint Spectrum LP, under Article III, Sections 3900, District B of the Zoning By-law, High Elevation Protection. The applicant seeks a Site Plan Approval from the Planning Board to install repeater antennas and ground equipment at the property located at Mt. Gilboa Road, Map/Parcel 18-4-002. (*Residential Class B Zone.*)

**Edward Pare, Jr.** legal representative of Printz Spectrum opened the hearing and introduced the various speakers who would supply information regarding the above cases. Literature was handed out to the Planning Board members. Copies of this literature are on file.

**Bill Hastings** explained the results of drive tests.

**Brady Gudell** of PCS Sprint gave information regarding various sites.

**Milo Caruso** gave information regarding the change in size of the building.

**Brion Koning** submitted information regarding sound and levels of sound coming from equipment.

Mr. Pare, stating that the new information is an improved design and meets all Provincetown Zoning By-laws, closed his presentation.

**Mark Hutchins**, Planning Board Consultant, of RF Engineering reviewed the Sprint application and did his own investigation and it compared with Sprint's.

Anne Howard opened the floor to questions and comments from the public.

**Celine Gandolpho**, **Jim McCollum** and **Lisa Westerveldt** all spoke against putting in a repeater antenna and other equipment as outlined by Sprint.

**Matthew Fallon** of Tiger Team Network Services asked what the height of the building on the wharf should be if that location was to be used.

Mr. Pare respectfully requested that the hearing be closed so the Planning Board could digest the material and make a decision within the statutory time frame.

The Planning Board decided not to close the hearing at this point in time.
