1. FINAL PREPARATION FOR JULY 4th EVENTS/FIREWORKS TASK FORCE

General Topics discussed

- **Parking on Route 6 – Public Safety Issue**
- **To ticket or not to ticket**
- **Parking at CCNS - Is there ample parking? People already park there.**
- **Place CCNS signage where Route 6 & 6A meet.**

David Nicolau – Definitely not in favor of ticketing on Route 6.

Sarah Peake – No parking on Route 6 - Free buses. Use the CCNS moving message signs to indicate where to Park or get a ticket and that there is NO parking on Route 6.

Michele Couture – Pubic Safety is the key issue on parking on Route 6.

Cheryl Andrews – Agree with Sarah's message. Follow signs and free parking – or get a ticket.

No enough spaces at the Seashore ... and should not charge for parking.

Cheryl ask the Task Force to let the Board know when they finally make their decision.

Get the word out to business, et al that money is needed for this event.

Fire Chief Trovato – Suggest putting lights up along Conwell for safety sake.

Marcene Marcoux - Suggest no ticketing – leave warning in prep for next events.
